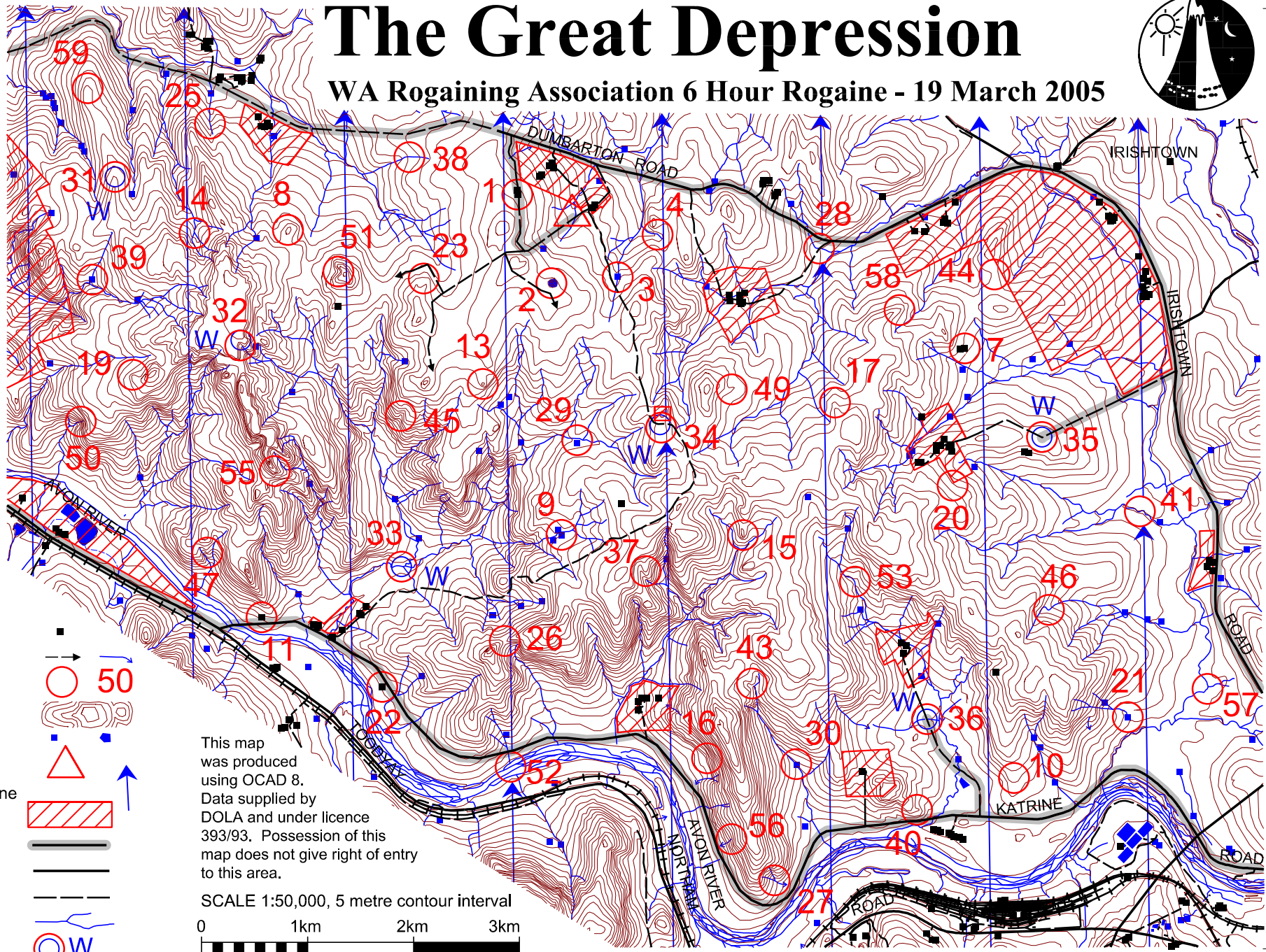

WA Rogaining Association 6 Hour Rogaine - 19 March 2005

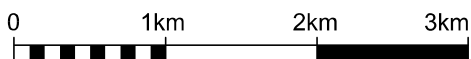
