Western Australian Rogaining Association Equal Opportunity Policy

The Western Australian Rogaining Association Inc (WARA) has a policy of Equal Opportunity that permits all members to compete in all regaining events and also to participate in the management of the sport.

Competing in Events.

The individual competitors are permitted to choose their own team members and teams can enter one of the following three Classes, in accordance with the gender of the team members:

Women, Men or Mixed

In addition, the above classes are broken up into the following categories:

Open, Veteran, Super Veteran, Ultra Veteran, Junior, Novice, Family, Cadet and University.

These Categories enable teams to compete against teams of the same age group thus enhancing their opportunity to win. However for safety reasons, any team that includes a competitor under the age of 14 years, must also include a team member 18 years or older.

Management of the Sport

WARA is managed entirely by volunteers. Any member is entitled to be nominated at an Annual General Meeting to stand for a position on the Association's Executive or Committee.

All members are welcome to volunteer to assist in the running of the association and events provided they adhere to the provisions of the Association's Constitution, follow the procedures of the Association's manuals and adhere to the Association's Risk Management Policy.
