

Rogaine Recycling Program

Overview

Equipment (supplied by Adventure Out on site)...

2 x long fold up tables
1 x Knife (sharp). Washing up bowl / liquid, Dishcloth / Scour, Tea towel x 2,
Gloves
Large Bag (egg shells) (for recycling tent)
2 x Small bucket (tea bags) (for hash house)
6 x Small Yellow wheelie bins (for recycling tent)
3 x large buckets (for Hash House)
2 x 120L yellow wheelie bins (for recycling tent)
2 x rectangle tubs (for meat and other food scraps for wash up area)
1 x trailer /ute to be parked behind recycling tent

Recycle Signage (supplied by Adventure Out on site)...

Egg Shells Only	Glass & Cans
Food Scraps	Plastic bottles & Containers
Meat Only	Paper & Cardboard (small)
Tea bags	Unrecyclable - rubbish

What to watch out for...

The biggest problem we have is **cross contamination** of foods and recyclables. Please be very cautious that items (organics, recyclables or rubbish) do not get placed in the wrong bin will mean that the process will not work.

Rogainers should not have access to the recycling tent for their personal rubbish. They are to be responsible for all their own waste/recycling other than food scraps which we accept at Area . 3 (see below). I.e. they take their own waste home. No bins are provided for participants.

Categories of separation...

1. Organic: meat, egg shells, other food scraps
2. Cans and glass
3. Plastic bottles and plastic containers
4. Clean paper and cardboard
5. Paper and cardboard with food or grease
6. Non-recyclable waste (plastic wraps, bags, gloves etc)

Rogaine Recycling Program

Procedures

Area 1 - Recycling Tent

This tent is supplied by WARA. It is similar to the first aid marque (3m x 3m) with a blue top and white walls. This is to be erected next to the Hash Hash house near the boiler and wash up table.

1 x Table

4 x small yellow bins:

- 1 x Cans (all metal) & glass
- 1 x Plastic bottles & containers only (no plastic wrapping)
- 1 x paper & cardboard. *Please break down large cardboard boxes & place flat in the Adventure Out trailer / ute (please note with food & grease gets broken up and put into organic waste)*
- 1x Unrecyclable waste (general rubbish)

2x 120 litre yellow bins for organic waste

- 1x Food Scraps
- 1x Meat

- Place 1x table in recycling tent for sorting of recyclables from Hash House
- Place 3x small litre yellow bins inside the recycling tent for recyclables
- 1x small yellow bin for un-recyclables wastes for front but still inside of recycling tent
- Place 2x small yellow bins inside recycling tent for organic waste
- 1 x large bag for egg shells
- Set up washing up bowl / liquid, Dishcloth / Scour, Tea towel x 2, - for cleaning recyclables.



STOP!

The recyclables must be rinsed before going into the respective wheelie bins.

Please break down large cardboard boxes & place flat in the Adventure Out trailer / ute

Area 2 - Hash House

3x Large white buckets for kitchen food scraps.

These are to be placed with in the Hash House (near rear exit) so that they can be readily accessed by people doing food prep and also emptied to the respective recycling tent wheelie bins. These bins must be labelled as below.

- 1 x Eggs shells only
- 1 x Meat only
- 1 x Other food scraps + greasy paper

1 x small bucket on tea & coffee table (again emptied into the respective bin in the recycling tent)

STOP!

These four buckets are to be emptied into respective small yellow bins in recycling tent regularly BUT you need to monitor the contents to avoid contamination.

Procedures (cont)

Area 3 - Wash up

- 1 x Table
- 1 x Food scraps (rectangle tub) (no meat)
- 1 x Meat Scraps only (rectangle tubs)

This is the wash up table for participants to wash their dishes. It is usually located in front of recycling tent adjacent to the boiler and Hash House.

Place 1x long table in front of wash up table & hot water boiler (several metres) so when people come to wash up plates they scrap plates into food scrap & meat buckets



Place 2x food scrap containers with signage the table making sure signage (e.g. meat only) is visible.

STOP!

These four buckets are to be emptied into respective small yellow bins in recycling tent regularly BUT you need to monitor the contents to avoid contamination.
